Please find the qualifications and application process for the Humanitarian WaSH MSc program below.

1. Be a holder of an undergraduate degree in any field of study from a recognized university with a minimum average of "Good" in one of the following programs:
 - Water and/or sanitation management
 - Public Health Health (hygiene promotion, behavior change, social work)
 - Hydraulics
 - Hydrogeology
 - The following fields could be considered under special condition: Epidemiology, agronomy, chemistry, Civil Engineering, Environmental Engineering or Environment Science, Mechanical Engineering, Chemical Engineering.

2. English Proficiency:
 - Obtain a minimum TOEFL score of 90/120 or IELTS score of 6.5. Only a certificate delivered by accredited Jordan bodies are accepted. These are:
 - British Council- Jordan Branch for IELTS
 - AMIDEAST- Jordan Branch for TOEFL

 - Or obtain a minimum Equivalent exam score of %75 from one of the following universities: (For Jordanian applicants only)
 - German Jordanian University
 - University of Jordan
 - Yarmouk University
 - Hashemite University
 - Mu'tah University

 - The English exam shouldn't be more than 2 years old.
 - The students can get conditional acceptance based on their score in TOEFL or IELTS from other bodies than the ones mentioned above. Provided that, students must retake the TOEFL, IELTS or the equivalent exam from the accredited bodies in Jordan. The pass

result must be submitted to the Deanship of Graduate studies before beginning of the program.

3. Passing the personal interview if we consider it necessary.
4. Recommendation letter from a party operating in the field of the Master program.
5. Motivation letter

7. Other Information:
 - The total number of credit hours is 36.
 - The cost per credit hour is JOD185 or equivalent in USD.
 - Students will attend full days for the whole week.
 - The lectures will be taken at GJU main campus in Al-Mushaqar/Madaba.

APPLICATION PROCESS

- Applications must be submitted through a Gmail account.

- Please note that electronic copies of these documents must be submitted and once accepted, the student must provide the original and certified documents in hand.

List of required documents:

1. An official high school transcript.
2. Graduation certificate certified by the authorities.
3. A certified Bachelor degree grades transcript.
4. Grading system for non-Jordanian universities.
5. Assessment and level placement by the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research in Jordan for graduates of foreign universities.
6. Written consent issued by the authorities in charge approving its holder's ability to attend this program (For Jordanian military personnel only)
7. A copy of the equation of the student's certificate from the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research in Jordan (For non-Jordanian universities)
8. A copy of the passport/travel document.
9. Two Portrait pictures of the applicant.
