The Deanship of Graduate Studies at the German Jordanian University announces the start of receiving applications for admission to master's programs offered for the first semester of the academic year (2021/2022), until the end of Sunday (22/08/2021).

Second: Submitting the application and paying the application fee:

For International Students:

1. Visit GJU website- Admission and Registration Department, My GJU Guests platform, fill the application and pay the application fees (25 JD non-refundable), via this link; <https://guests.gju.edu.jo/faces/index.xhtml>

Third: Requirements:

Receiving the applications will be on the first semester and the studying will start on the second semester (February 2021/2022)

- Be a holder of an undergraduate degree in any field of study from a recognized university with a minimum average of "Good" in one of the following programs:
 - Water and/or sanitation management
 - Public Health (hygiene promotion, behavior change, social work)
 - Hydraulics
 - Hydrogeology

- The following fields could be considered under special condition: Epidemiology, agronomy, chemistry, Civil Engineering, Chemical Engineering, Environmental Engineering or Environment Science.
- Passing the English proficiency Exam.
- Passing the personal interview if required.
- Recommendation letter from a party operating in the field of the Master program.
- Motivation letter
- Professional experience in NGO or private sector related to Water, sanitation, and/or public health (Preferred)
- Credit hour fee; JD 185/ credit hour
- Credit hours number: 36 credit hours
- Studying will be at GJU campus.
- Lectures will be daily, starting at 8:00 AM and finishing at 5:00 PM.
- The applicant's university should be accredited by the Ministry of Higher Education in Jordan, check via this link: <http://rce.mohe.gov.jo/en/RecognizedUniversities>

Fourth: The required documents are:

Note: Copies of these documents shall be submitted electronically and the original or certified copies should be submitted to the University upon official acceptance.

1. A scanned copy of your Identification Card (for Jordanians) or a scanned copy of your passport (for non-Jordanians).
2. A scanned copy of your High School Certificate. For Non-Jordanians, a scanned copy of the High School Equivalency Certificate issued by the Jordanian Ministry of Education.
3. A scanned copy of your Bachelor degree certificate and transcripts, and any other degrees (if applicable).
4. A copy of the equivalent certificate from the Jordanian Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research for graduates of non-Jordanian universities.
5. The university scores system for graduates from non-Jordanian universities
6. an estimate from Jordan Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research for graduates of foreign universities or universities for which there is no estimate
7. A scanned copy of your English Language proficiency exam result (IETLS or TOEFL – less than two years old – see details at point 10 below).
8. A recent passport-size personal photo (size: 4 cm x 6 cm or 5 cm x 5 cm).
9. A copy of the non-refundable application fees (JD 25) voucher.
10. English Language Exam (one of them):

The applicant must have a score approved by the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research in one of the English language exams, as follows:

- Graduate Studies Council decision (132/14/2018/2019): About the exam center of British Council- Jordan Branch for IELTS and AMIDEAST- Jordan Branch for TOEFL:
- **The Council decided, for the purposes of accepting its international request from outside Jordan and accepting Jordanian students residing outside the country and giving an opportunity to apply for admission to master's programs for students who obtained an acceptable result in these international exams other than the centers mentioned above:**
 - A. Agree to issue an initial acceptance after the relevant school and the Deanship of Graduate Studies recommendation, provided that the student submits an English language proficiency level test held by the university before the start of study in the program. Students who pass the English requirement will be allowed to start their study and no student will be allowed to take the first semester for English proficiency preparation (all students will have to start together in the first semester).**
 - B. Students who are initially accepted and who pass the exam will register the courses according to the study plan and issue them with regular admission notices.**
